Why PRAXIS?

*'Praxis' can be described as the process by which a **theory is put into practice**. In relation to the Christian faith, it can be about how we studying and applying God's word so we can experience greater success in our personal lives and ministry...it is to study, serve and succeed!*

Praxis Ministry Academy (PMA) exists as a school of adult education, primarily for lay people, to provide foundational training in biblical and doctrinal studies, church ministry skills and leadership skills so they may be better prepared to do the "work of the ministry" (Eph 4:12).*

PMA is also a part of Hampden Chapel's 20/20 Vision to offer adult Christian education courses at Hampden. It reflects the desire of Hampden's leadership to develop Christian leaders that will make an impact for God in their home church and wider community.

*A PMA certificate does not confer any ministerial status.
